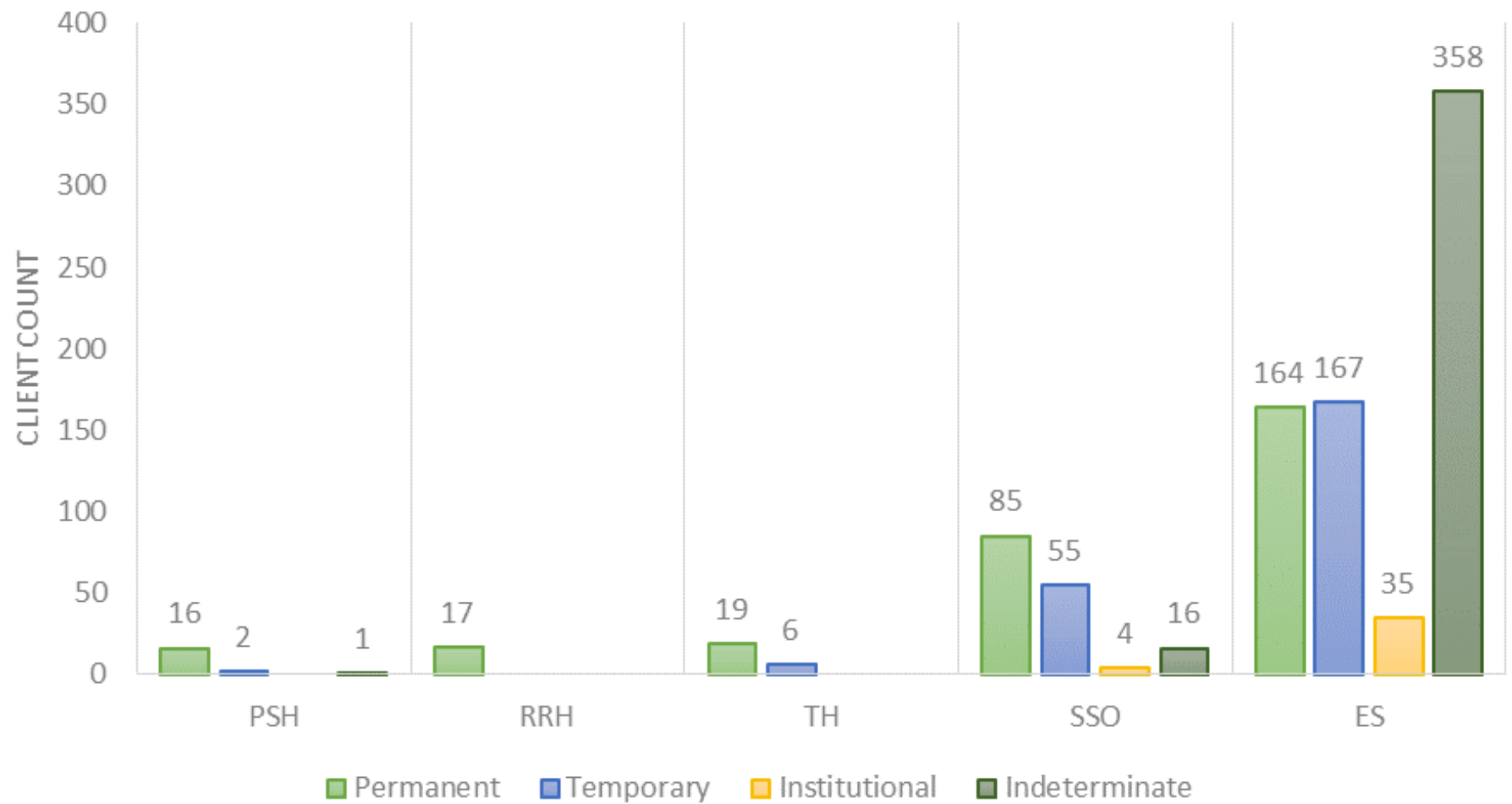

- SSO: Supportive Services Only Program

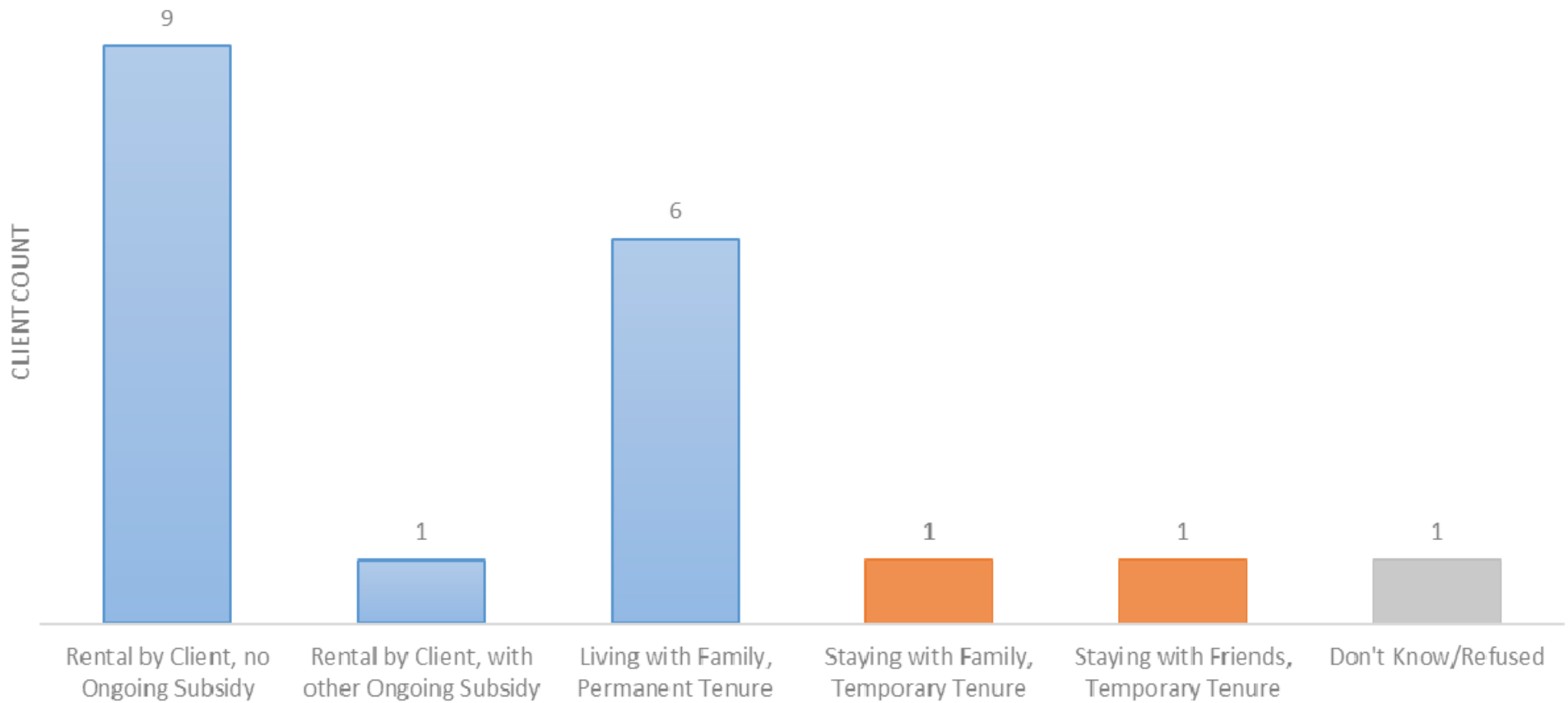

Exit Destination Types by Program Type

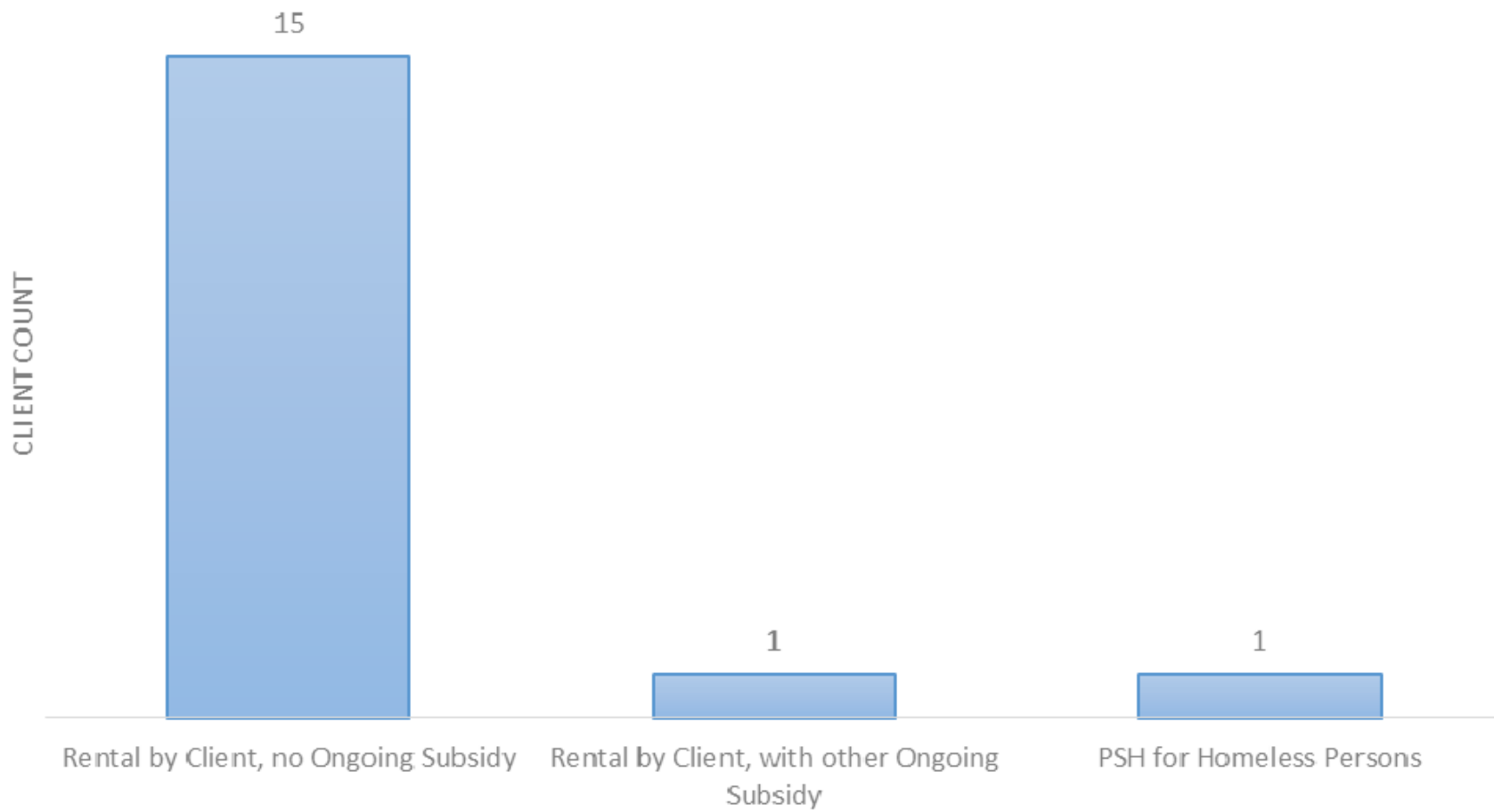


Exiting Permanent Supportive Housing

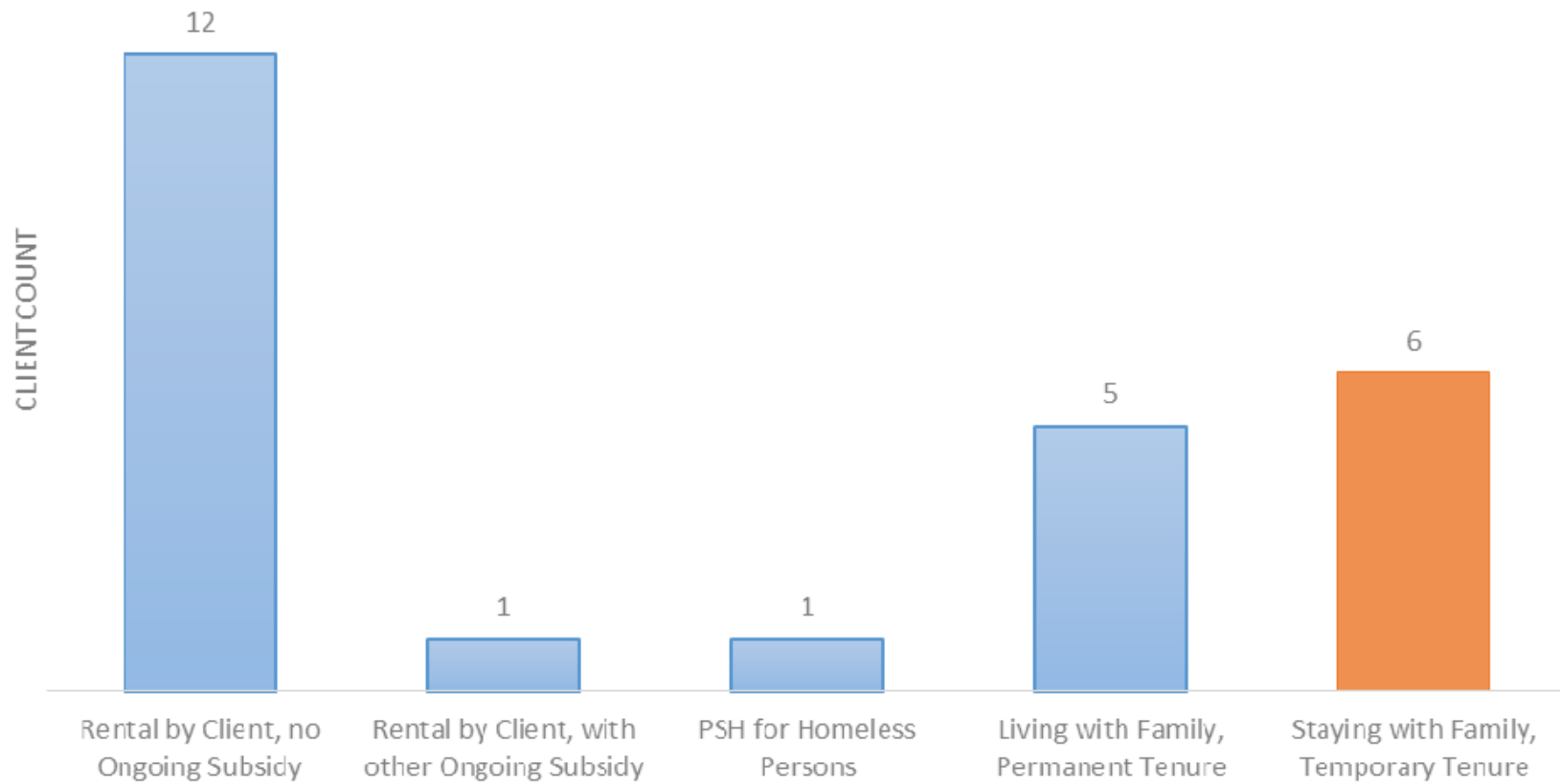


Temporary exits denoted by orange color, indeterminate exits denoted by gray color

Exiting Rapid Re-Housing

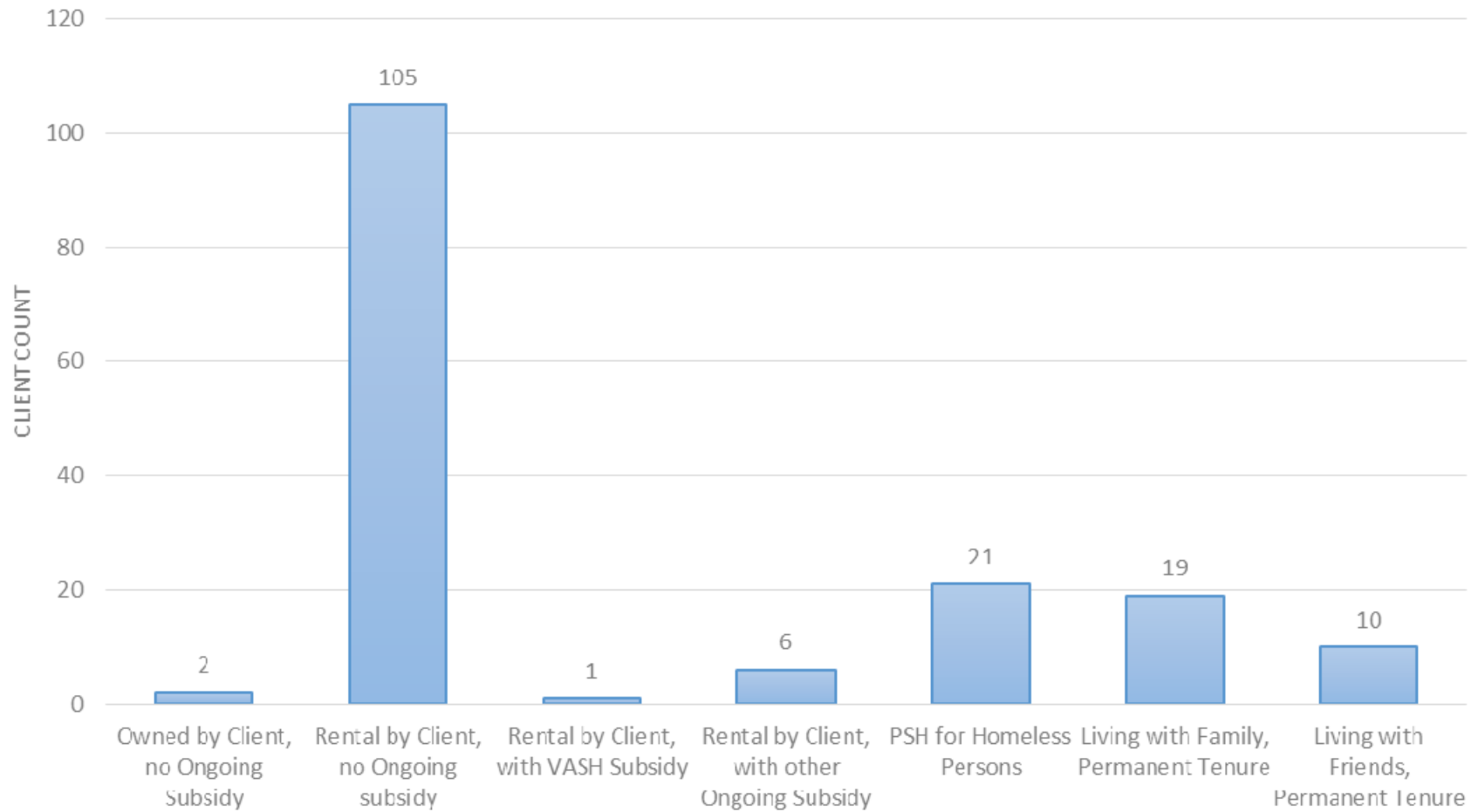


Exiting Transitional Housing

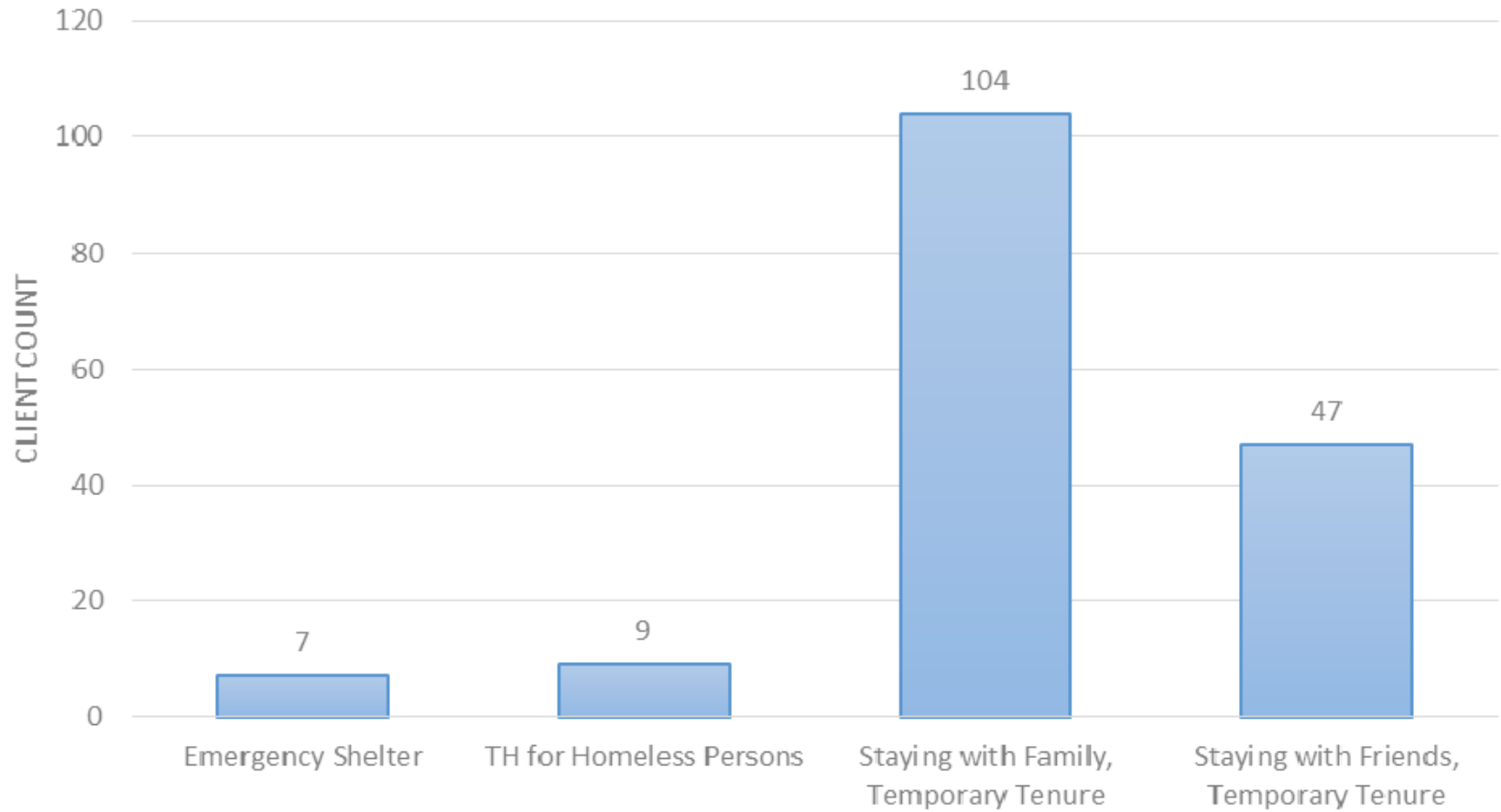

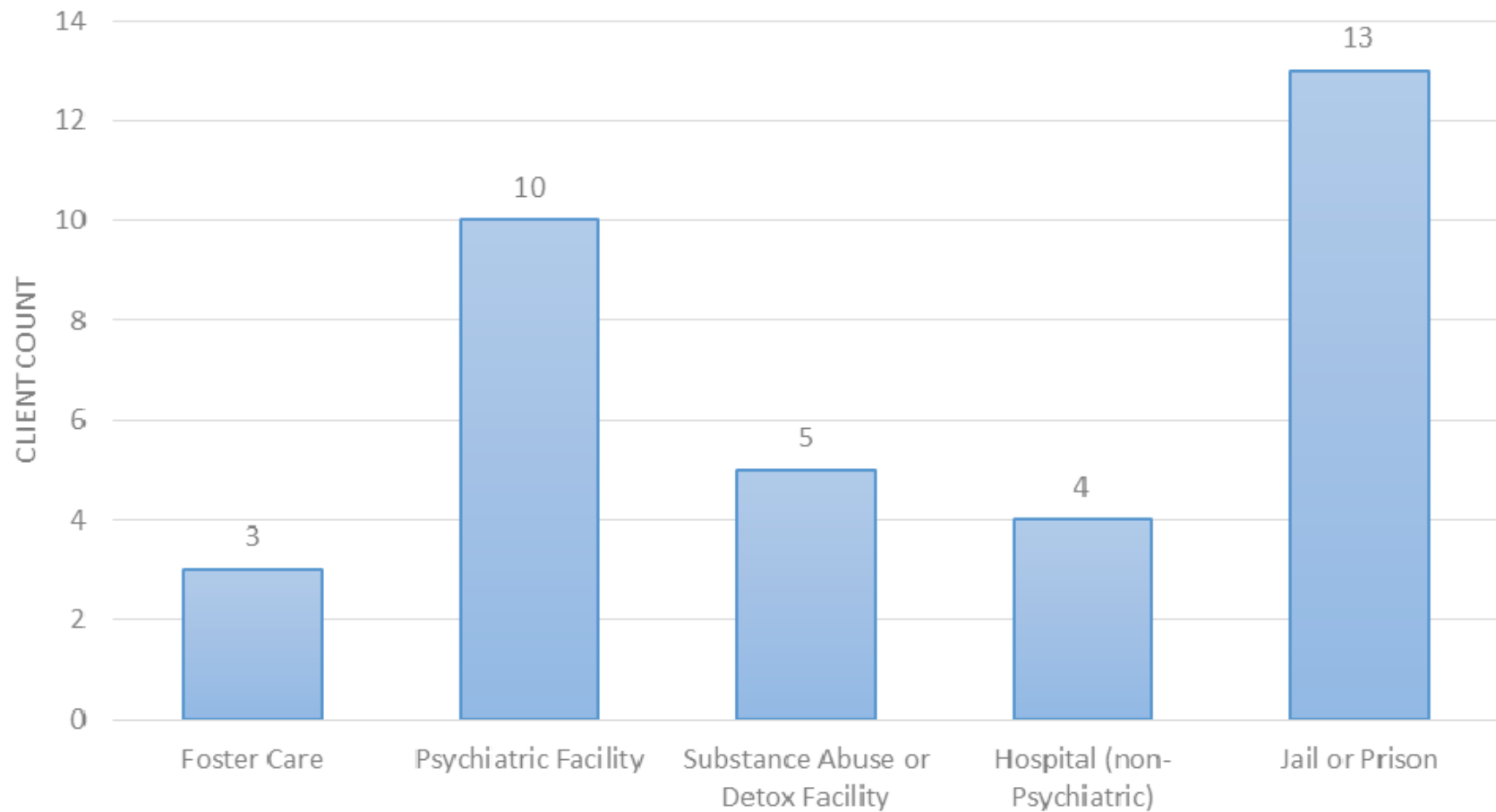
Exiting Emergency Shelter for Permanent Destinations



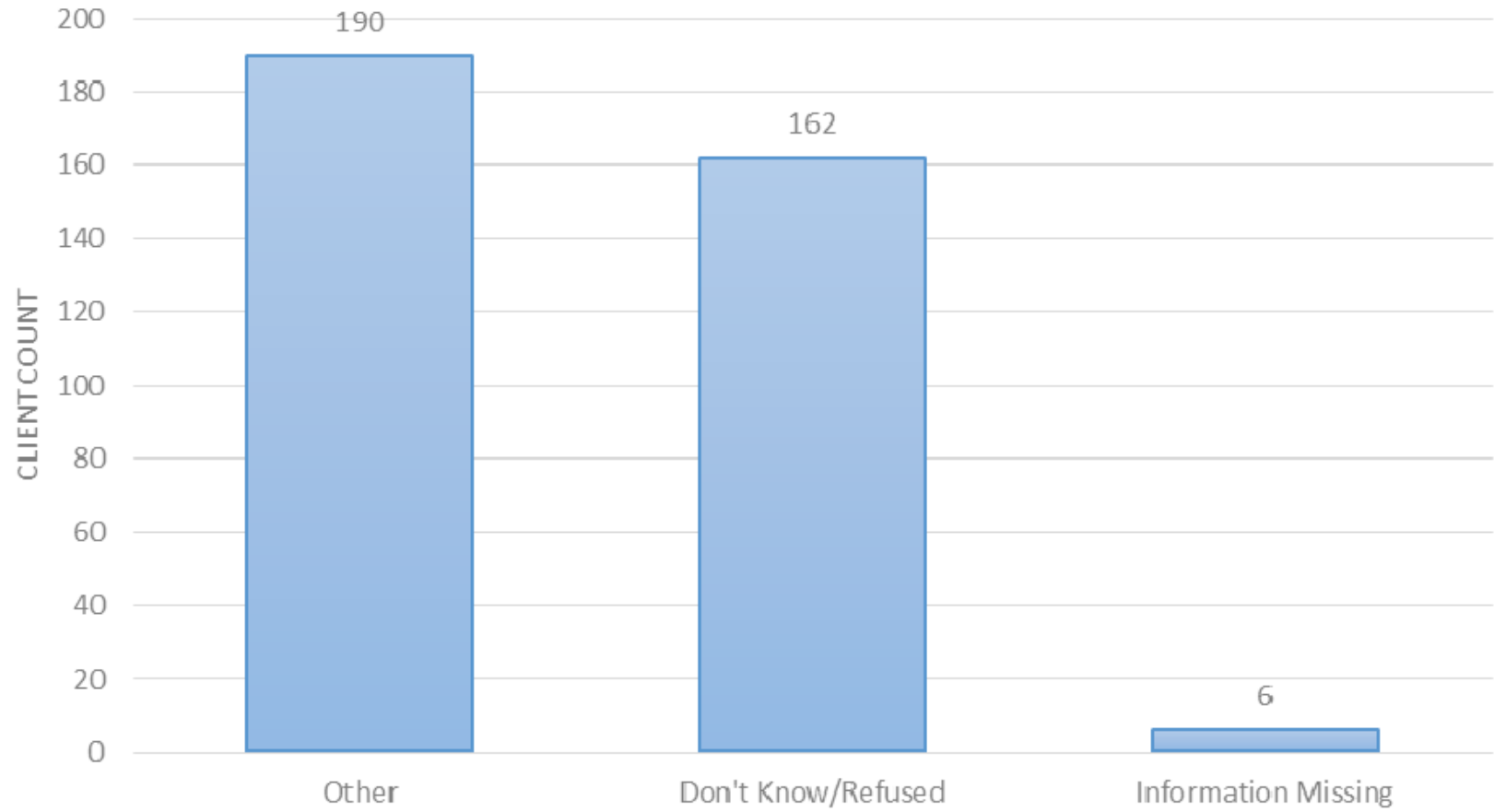
Exiting Emergency Shelter for Temporary Destinations



Exiting Emergency Shelter for Institutional Destinations



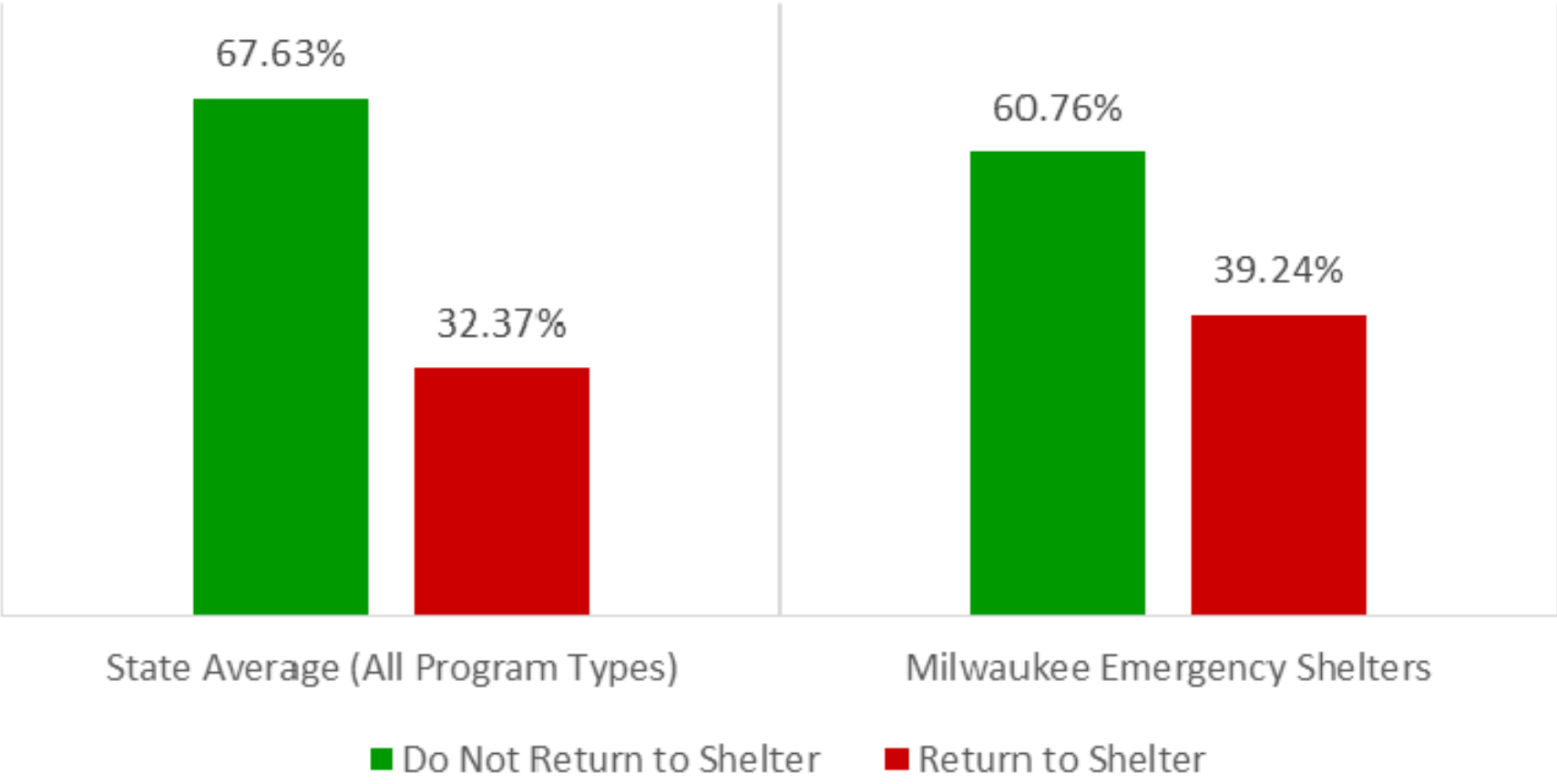
Exiting Emergency Shelter for Indeterminate Destinations



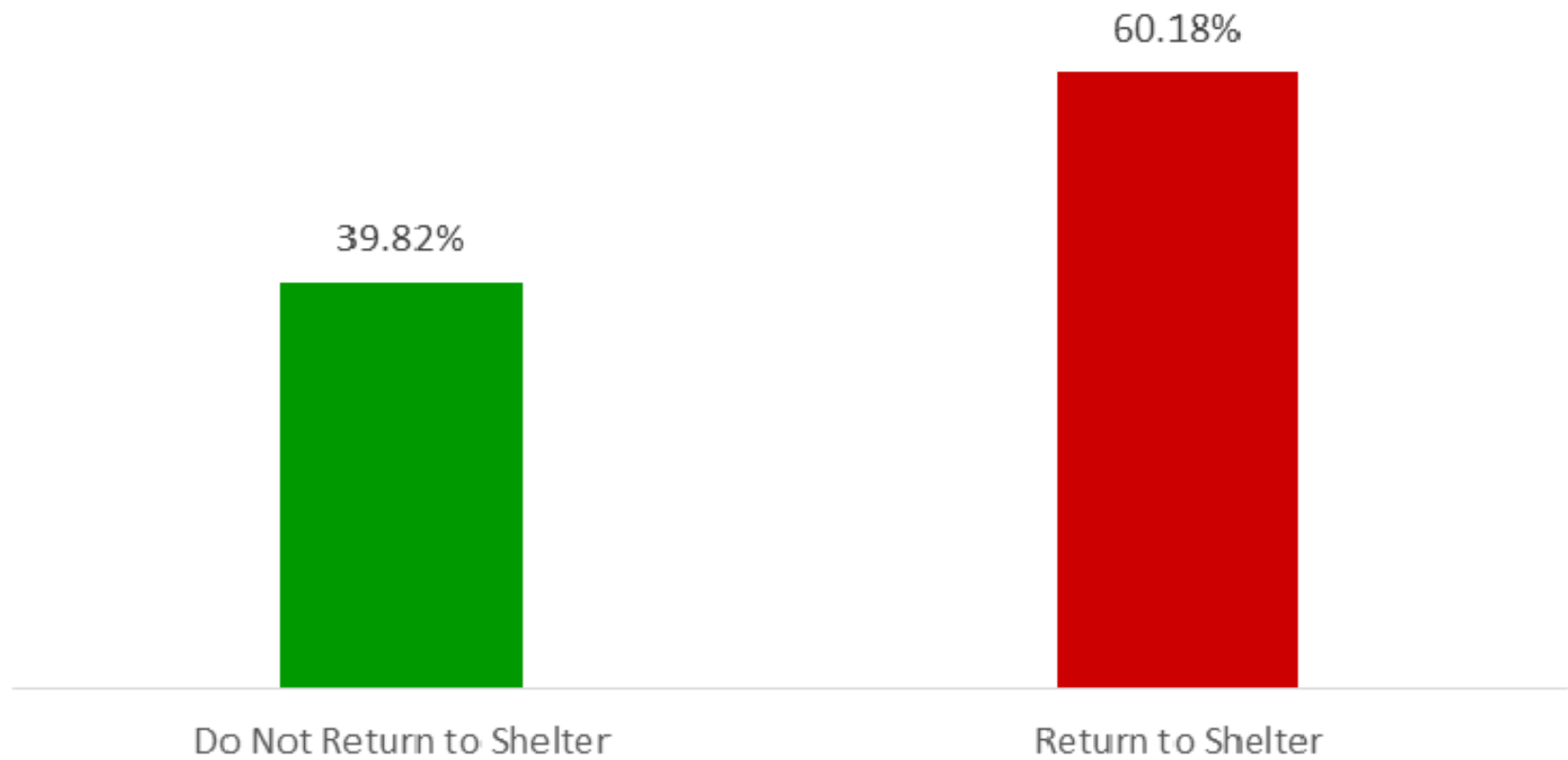

After people leave programs in Racine, do they return to shelter?

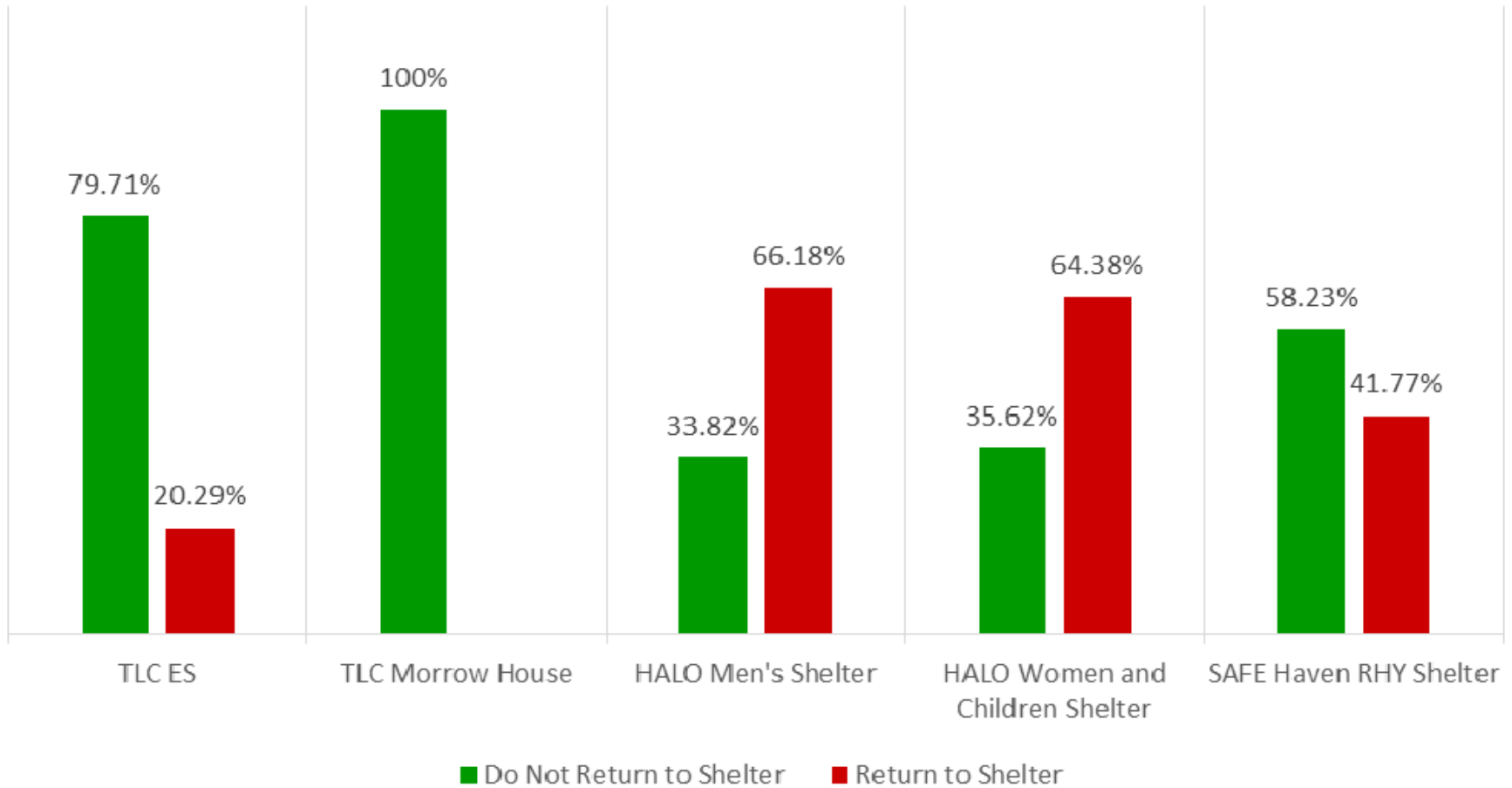
Shelter Recurrence - Points of Comparison

SHELTER RECURRENCE: FACTS AND FIGURES

Of the 111 people served in Racine shelters with a monthly income of over \$1000, only 36 (32.43%) did not return to shelter.

Of the 314 family members served in Racine shelters, only 143 (45.54%) did not return to shelter.

HUD PERFORMANCE MEASURES

Housing Stability – percentage of participants that achieve housing stability in an operating year

Total Income – percentage of participants that increased their income from entry date to program exit

Earned Income – percentage of participants that increased their income from employment from entry date to program exit
