e. Non-HMIS coordinated entry list update:

Racine CoC has been using a DV non-HMIS coordinate entry list for the transition from service point to clarity. A meeting took place with Bethany and Women's Resource Center, to switch from the non-HMIS CE list to utilizing a housing navigator or Iraida until we have the housing navigator back in place. Those referrals will be transferred into Clarity. After the transition from service point to Clarity, coordinate entry will no longer be using the non-HMIS list.

This was a good move forward trying to make sure that we're getting all the data on one system and will be evaluating or monitoring, to get a full picture of our system. We will be updating policies to reflect the change.
